I got all the confidence I needed from the responses that I got in the dancehalls. In 1996 I migrated to the United States of America where I am still living. I performed on a few shows; some of them were great, and some of them had bands that were not so hip to reggae. When I was living in Jamaica, I wrote five songs. Since I am living here in New York, I wrote one song. I recorded three of my songs on CD in the year 2003 and 2006.
